Riva del Garda, 15th - 20th September 2009

NEARLY 500 REGISTRATIONS FROM 40 COUNTRIES FOR THE 15th ANNUAL MEETING OF THE EUROPEAN ASSOCIATION OF ARCHAEOLOGISTS

There are less than three months to the 15th Annual Meeting of the European Association of Archaeologists (EAA) and the number of registrations nearly amounts to 500. For the 2009 Meeting, which will take place from 15th to 20th September, Riva del Garda has been chosen by the EAA as the host town.

The Meeting is organised by the “*Settore Beni archeologici della Soprintendenza per Beni librari archivistici e archeologici*” (Department for Archaeological Goods of the Heritage Office of Archaeological Archival and Book Goods) of the Province of Trento and by the Town Council of Riva del Garda, in collaboration with the Museum of Riva del Garda, which hosts an important archaeological collection.

The Meeting goes far beyond European borders: 40 countries will be represented at the Meeting, amongst which United States of America, Russia, Serbia, Israel, Canada, Macedonia, Australia, Cyprus, Egypt, Japan, Taiwan and Turkey.

The busy programme of the Meeting is subdivided into a total of 54 sessions: 11 sessions will be held daily at the same time. An exhibition hall will be set up in the same conference hall used for the Meeting (*Palazzo dei Congressi*), where exhibitor companies of the sector and prestigious publishing houses will have the possibility to promote themselves. Some of the most famous publishing houses present at the Meeting are: Cambridge University Press, Routledge / Taylor and Francis, All’Insegna del Giglio, Carocci Editore, Oxbow Books, Archaeolingua Foundation, Edizioni Saecula - Weirstudio, Maney Publishing, Wiley Blackwell, in addition to the Institute for Archaeologists.

Activities at the Museum of Riva del Garda, as well as excursions, guided tours and cultural initiatives aiming at an interaction with the territory, will be organised.

The Meeting is an exceptional event that offers the unique chance for an exchange of ideas and opinions on archaeological theory and practice, with the intent to bring about constant
