**TRENTINO HOSTS THE 15th ANNUAL MEETING OF THE EUROPEAN ASSOCIATION OF ARCHAEOLOGISTS**

From the 15th to the 20th of September, Riva del Garda will be the European capital of archaeology: the town will host the 15<sup>th</sup> EAA (European Association of Archaeologists) Annual Meeting. The meeting is organised by the Archaeological Heritage Office of the Province of Trento and by the Town Council of Riva del Garda (whose Museum hosts an important archaeological collection) and will attract in Trentino hundreds of archaeologists from all over Europe and from overseas. This event of major importance will be the occasion for the participants for an exchange of opinions, in order to foster a debate about the different natures of archaeology in Europe and to encourage cooperation amongst organisations which deal with this discipline.

The Meeting will take place in the *Congress Centre* in the space of 6 days and will consist of scientific meetings, round tables, presentations of posters and a temporary bookshop together with the possibility for publishing houses of the sector to promote themselves. Other activities at the Museum of Riva del Garda, as well as excursions, guided tours and cultural initiatives aiming at an interaction with the territory will be organised.

The EAA is an international association, whose members are archaeologists (professionals and enthusiasts), academic personalities, research workers, archaeologists working in public sectors which deal with the management of the archaeological heritage, directors and curators of museums, teachers, historians and students. The members are more than 1,100, come from 41 different countries and study prehistoric, classical, medieval and recent archaeology.

Amongst the various events organised by the EAA, the Annual Meeting is a very important occasion for members to exchange opinions and personal experiences and is hosted every year by a different European town. The previous meetings took place in Ljubljana, Slovenia (1994); Santiago de Compostela, Spain (1995); Riga, Latvia (1996); Ravenna, Italy (1997); Göteborg, Sweden (1998); Bournemouth, Great Britain (1999); Lisbon, Portugal (2000), Esslingen am Neckar, Germany (2001), Thessaloniki, Greece (2002), St. Petersburg, Russia (2003), Lyon, France (2004), Cork, Ireland (2005), Cracow, Poland (2006), Zadar, Croatia (2007), Malta (2008).
